The True Cost of Converting

 Equipment costs of converting from oil to gas can total \$5,000-\$10,000 or more.¹

 These figures don't account for additional costs associated with running a gas line to your property and removing your oil tank, nor do they include the plumbing, electrical and landscaping work required.

 If you have a chimney, it needs to be inspected and protected with a steel liner, which could cost thousands more.²

- It can take 9 years or longer to see a payback on your conversions costs.
- Historically, natural gas prices in the Northeast have been higher than oil prices.³
- In the winter of 2013-2014, natural gas spot prices skyrocketed from around \$4/MMBtu (million British thermal units, the standard unit of measurement for heat energy) to over \$100/MMBtu.⁴
